Site Conditions

- Appropriate foot protection in use

Tools and Equipment

- Tools/equipment inspected before use
- Guards and safety devices in place
- Electrical equipment properly grounded

Hazard Controls

- Fall protection used as required
- Scaffolding, ladders in good condition
- Proper signage on hazardous areas

Emergency Procedures

- First aid kit available and accessible
- Emergency contact numbers displayed
- Fire extinguishers inspected and accessible
