<b>3. Planning</b>		
Are environmental aspects and impacts identified and assessed?		
Are compliance obligations determined and up to date?		
Are objectives set, monitored, and reviewed?		
<b>4. Support</b>		
Are resources and responsibilities clearly assigned?		
Is there evidence of employee competence and awareness?		
<b>5. Operation</b>		
Are operational controls implemented and maintained?		
Is emergency preparedness and response adequately addressed?		
<b>6. Performance Evaluation</b>		
Are monitoring and measurement processes in place?		
Are regular internal audits conducted and recorded?		
<b>7. Improvement</b>		
Are corrective actions taken to address nonconformities?		
Is there evidence of continual improvement of the EMS?
