5. Are incidents and accidents investigated thoroughly and shared for learning purposes?
6. Do you believe that safety concerns are addressed promptly by supervisors or management?
7. Are appropriate resources (PPE, equipment, tools) provided to perform your job safely?
8. Have you ever witnessed co-workers taking shortcuts that bypass safety procedures?
9. Do you believe your co-workers value safety as much as production?
10. Is there an open line of communication for discussing workplace safety ideas or concerns?
