### 1. Definition of Confidential Information

For the purpose of this Agreement, "Confidential Information" shall mean any information or material that is proprietary to either party and not generally known by non-party individuals, including but not limited to business strategies, financial information, client lists, product designs, trade secrets, and any other private information disclosed during the course of business.

### 2. Non-Disclosure

### 3. Non-Compete Clause

During the term of this Agreement and for a period of  12 months following its termination, the Receiving Party agrees not to directly or indirectly engage in or assist any business that competes with the Disclosing Party within a radius of  50 miles from the principal place of business of the Disclosing Party.

### 4. Term and Termination

This Agreement shall commence on the Effective Date and continue for a period of  1 year(s) unless terminated earlier by written notice. Obligations regarding Confidential Information and non-compete shall survive termination as outlined herein.

### 5. Governing Law
