

Office Cleaning Checklist for Professional Cleaners

General Areas

- Clean sinks and polish faucets
- Empty and sanitize trash and recycling bins
- Sweep and mop floors
- Restock paper towels, tissues, soap, and dish supplies

Restrooms

- Clean and disinfect sinks, faucets, and countertops
- Sanitize toilets and urinals (inside and out)
- Refill soap dispensers, toilet paper, and paper towels
- Wipe down mirrors and partitions
- Empty sanitary bins and trash
- Mop floors with disinfectant

Other Tasks

- Restock cleaning supplies as necessary
- Report maintenance issues
- Check for and report lost property
- Turn off lights and secure premises as instructed
