1. Definition of Confidential Information

"Confidential Information" means any data or information, oral or written, disclosed by the Disclosing Party to the Receiving Party that is not generally known to the public and that the Receiving Party understands is proprietary.

2. Obligations of Receiving Party

- To maintain the confidentiality of the Confidential Information.
- Not disclose Confidential Information to third parties without written consent.
- Use the Confidential Information only for the purpose related to the business partnership.

3. Limitations

This Agreement does not apply to information which is:

- Publicly available at the time of disclosure or becomes public through no fault of the Receiving Party.
- Already in the possession of the Receiving Party prior to disclosure.
- Obtained by the Receiving Party from a third party lawfully.
- Independently developed by the Receiving Party without reference to the Confidential Information.

4. Term

This Agreement shall remain in effect for _____ years from the date signed by both parties, or until the Confidential Information no longer qualifies as confidential.

5. Return or Destruction of Information

Upon request, the Receiving Party shall return or destroy all copies of Confidential Information in their possession.
