## Scoring Criteria

Score	Likelihood	Impact
1	Rare: Highly unlikely to occur	Negligible: Minimal project effect
2	Unlikely: Not expected but possible	Minor: Minor schedule, budget or quality impact
3	Possible: Might occur occasionally	Moderate: Noticeable effect; may need management attention
4	Likely: Will probably occur	Major: Major cost, quality, or schedule deviation
5	Almost Certain: Expected to occur frequently	Severe: Critical impact on project success

## Risk Level Interpretation

- **1-6:** Low Risk – Monitor
- **7-14:** Moderate Risk – Mitigation required
- **15-25:** High Risk – Immediate action needed
